"The Australian Sparkling Wine Show (ASWS) is the only dedicated sparkling wine show in Australia. With the objective "to showcase and provide nationally recognised opportunities and benchmarking for Australia's sparkling wine producers," we are excited to bring you the 2024 results.

Originally the Marysville Sparkling Wine Festival, the ASWS began as a seed that grew out of the ashes of a community shattered by the February 2009 Black Saturday bushfires. Since its inaugural year in 2010, the ASWS has evolved and expanded and is now a renowned inclusion on the Australian wine show calendar.

In 2024 we saw 181 entries from across the country, which shows the breadth of diversity of Australian sparkling wines, across a number of different styles.

We once again welcomed renowned winemaker and consultant Jeremy Dineen as our Chair of Judges, who lead a stellar cast of judges from across the country.

In 2024 we moved the show to Tasmania, along with support of Wine Tasmania who come on board with a new trophy – Best Tasmanian Sparkling wine, and we saw an increase in Tasmanian exhibitors both large and small which is gratifying to see.

We thank everyone for their support, from exhibitors, sponsors, judges, the committee, and the many volunteers both past and present who have all contributed to make the Show what it is today.



## **Chair of Judges Report**

For the first time in the history of the show, judging moved to Tasmania, recognising the importance of this style to the Island State and encouraging a greater number of Tasmanian Entries.

Over two wild and windy days in late August, a team of five judges (including an MW, a Len Evans Dux and some highly experienced sparkling winemakers) have tasted, scored, discussed, retasted and ranked 181 Australian Sparkling Wines. Seven classes, covering wines from early drinking, fruity tank fermented styles through to wines with lees age in excess of five years were carefully catalogued, organised and poured for the judging team by a dedicated team of industry volunteers, making it easy for the judges to focus on the wines and discuss the merits of each wine without any clues to the identity of the producer or product. Despite the foul weather outside, judging facilities provided by Tamar Ridge Wines were excellent with plenty of natural light.


The results, again highlight the fruit resource and viticultural and winemaking excellence in the Australian sparkling wine scene across a diverse range of styles. From 181 entries, an extraordinary 70% were awarded a medal. Across the show, there were a total of 16 Gold medals, representing 9% of entries – an incredibly strong result, dominated by the extended lees age wines but spread across every class.



## A few highlights include:

- Class 7 Sparkling Reds, a class that is often disappointing in wine shows produced two gold medals with a complex, older wine and a delicious fresher style.
- Class 6, the wines that don't fit into the traditional classes, while not awarding a gold medal this year, there was a strong array of diverse styles almost universally well made.
- Class 5, Prosecco a very strong class that shows the high quality of both Prosecco fruit and winemaking in Australia continues despite the ongoing debate with the EU over the right to use the name Prosecco.
- Class 4, Sparkling Rosé generated a lot of discussion amongst the panel with a total of 4 delicious and diverse wines receiving top awards.
- Class 2, Bottle fermented wines with 24-60 months tirage age a remarkably strong class with very few faults and strong diversity of styles. 66% of these wines scored a medal, with a wide range of producers and regions proving that high quality sparkling is in a very healthy place around the country.
- Class 1, Bottle Fermented Extended Yeast Age Sparkling Classic Varieties (White or Rose), 60 months or longer tirage age Some ridiculously good wines from producers with long-term vision and commitment to age their wines on lees for extended periods. As with last year, there was robust debate about the styles and it is a real pity that only one of these could get the Top Gold award and trophy as there were several wines that could have easily been crowned here.

Entries were received from nearly every GI across the country that makes sparkling wines, and medals were awarded to nearly every winemaking state in the country. There are too many GIs to list individually but there were particularly strong entries from Victoria, across a diverse range of varieties and styles, and from Tasmania, dominated by bottle fermented classic varieties with extended lees age. The move to judging in Tasmania stimulated local entries, with a total of 56 Tasmanian wines in 2024, compared with 35 the previous year. While Victorian entry numbers were very slightly down on last year, they produced 25% of the gold medals awards in the show, as did South Australia. The stand-out for me however (with no parochial bias, of course), was Tasmania's performance with 7 of the 16 gold medals (44%) awarded at the show.



There is no better proponent of the diverse assortment of sparkling wines in our country than the Winequip Lallemand Australian Sparkling Wine Show, and I would encourage all lovers of sparkling wines to seek out the award winners from across the styles and classes, as they truly represent the best expressions of their styles in Australia.

To every producer who entered, thank you for your hard work and support of this specialised show, which would not exist without the amazing grape growers and winemakers. Thanks also to my fellow judges, the generous sponsors and the hardworking volunteer committee and particularly Trina Smith in her last year as Committee Chair. Without all of these dedicated contributors it would not be possible to put on such a smooth and enjoyable wine show and showcase the amazing Australian Sparkling Wines.

**Comments:** Haiku comments - Aged bubbles arise, Light transcending through the years, Blooming at dawn's break.

Judges comments - Impressive power and complexity but still amazing freshness from wines with long lees age. Balancing yeast complexity with delicacy and fruit is a fine art and the best wines show the deft handling, foresight and patience of the producers. A few wines lack the quality of fruit or delicacy of handing to match the tirage age.


